The Revd. George Gainsford was  
instrumental in founding a Trust in  
1868 to build almshouses and an  
orphanage by public subscription

**Holy Saviour Church**  
Consecrated on Ascension Day, 1865

Architect: William Butterfield  
Revd. George Gainsford was the first  
Vicar



**St Bridget's**

Opened as an orphanage in 1873,  
became a private house in 1950's
